THANKFUL TURKEY

Cut a head, body, wings, and feet from poster board. Decorate them with cardstock, yarn, and markers.



Cut 15 feathers from cardstock. Write something you're thankful for on each feather. Glue or tape them onto the turkey.

Adult turkeys have 5,000–6,000 feathers, including 18 large quill feathers on their tails.
