





Shark Treasure Box

Make a shark treasure box to store ideas for spreading kindness.

1. Cut six fins and two tails from **thin cardboard**. Bend a 1/2-inch flap on the bottom of each piece.
2. **Glue** the pieces together in pairs, leaving the flaps unglued. Glue the fin and tail flaps to an **empty tissue box**. Hold them in place with **masking tape** while the glue dries.
3. **Paint** the shark or cover it with **paper**. Let it dry.
4. **Cut** teeth, eyes, and a mouth from felt. **Glue** them on.
5. Write ideas for kind things to do on small slips of **paper**. Each day, stick your hand in the shark's mouth and pick an idea to try.
